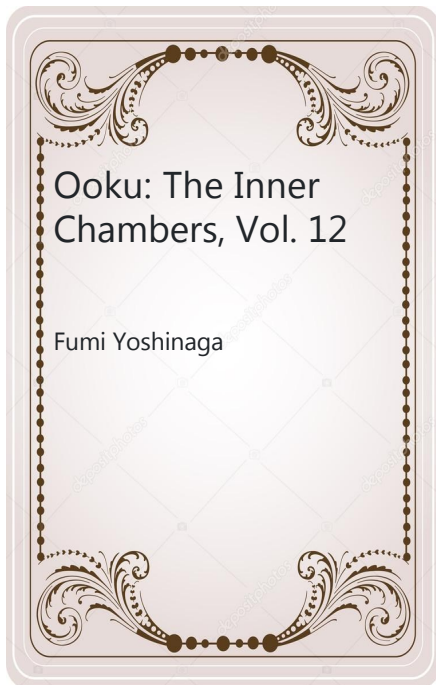


Ooku: The Inner Chambers, Vol. 12
