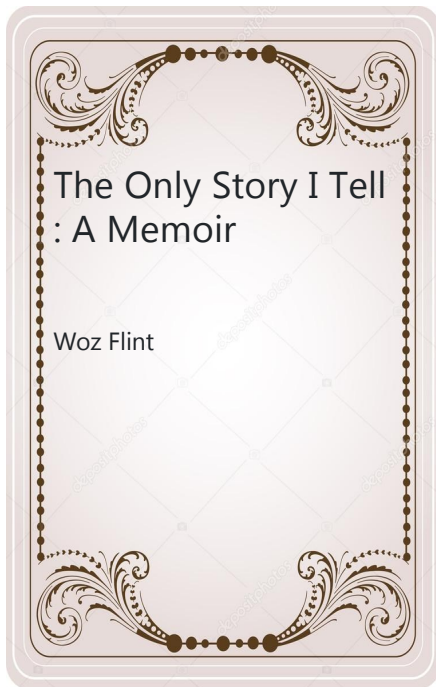


The Only Story I Tell : A Memoir

Woz Flint's story began when she was five years old, on the cold winter morning when her mother was found murdered in her home. For every new chapter Woz has begun in her life, the pages always turn back to December 17, 1981. She survived ovarian cancer as a child. She secretly endured a sexual assault as a teenager. She searched for answers in cross-country moves and multiple marriages, never finding what she was looking for: the peace, comfort, and security she lost when her mom was taken from her. Thirty-six years later, Woz is raising a son of her own, navigating motherhood without a model and wishing her own mommy would walk through the door. Yet through all her uncertainty, Woz is finding her way. Woz's story is one of resilience, of longing and loving, and of ultimately realizing that the strength she needs has been inside her all along.
